WHY USE HEARING ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY?

Designed specifically for individuals with hearing loss. Technology can:

- provide better hearing in noisy environments,
- allow the user to increase the volume and clarity of spoken communication,
- make everyday activities easier and safer,
- help to improve social interaction,
- improve relationships and increase confidence and self-esteem.

ITEMS AVAILABLE TO BORROW INCLUDE



Telephones Devices (amplified phones, headsets, add-on amplifiers, Bluetooth devices, neckloops, and more)



Alerting Devices (watches, alarm clocks, smoke detectors, baby monitors, doorbell and telephone alerting systems, paging systems, and more)



Listening Devices (personal listening systems, group listening systems, television listening systems, and professional devices such as amplified stethoscopes)
